

Marco X60 A Big Hit at the Emergency Services Show 2009

The unveiling at this year's Emergency Services Show of Marco Trailers' all new, X60 Mobile Treatment Centre for St John Ambulance marked the latest development in a long association.

The six-metre unit, specially designed for St John Ambulance Lancashire, was the centre of attention among officers from divisions across the country. As well as comments on Marco's build quality and finish, a major talking point was the use of LPG energy. The unit's electricity generator, heating and hot water are powered from two propane canisters with automatic change-over, providing exceptional ease of use.

Also of considerable interest amongst St John Ambulance visitors was the Marco MX50 motorised unit, prepared for the NHS. Described as an excellent set-up, the unit was recognised as a positive way forward for several divisions.
